The Presidential car and other cars were thrning onto Stemmons Pwy. Some of the bystanders said the shots came from the overpass. I ran across the street (Elm) and up the imbankment over the retaining wall and into the freight ward and was unable to locate anything, IV located one (1) witness H. W. Betzner w/m 5922 Velasco Dr. phone TA-1-9761. He had taken some photos just prior to the shots (35mm film) Betzner was taken by me to the Sheriffs office for a statement. I took the camera and film to ID and had the film developed. Betzner had three (3) pictures just seconds prior to the rifle shots. The camera and negatives were returned to Betzner. The three (3) pictures were retained by me. Officer Homer Reynolds DFD obtained a statement from Betzner. The glossy prints of the pictures were turned over to Officer Reynolds to be placed with Betzners statement. After I had left the film in ID, I got a battery powered light and ment over to the Texas School Book Bepository to help with the search of building. I proceeded to the sixth (6th) floor of the building to search for the rifle. I started on the east and of the building andworked my way to the west end of the building.
