conversation occurred at Ft. Chaffin, Arkansas during conversation occurred in met MAJOR STAVIS ELLIS at the Fourth U. S. Army ARRA Intelligence School. MAJOR ELLIS stated Fourth U. S. Gimy Finds. Officer assigned to the Traffid Enforcement

The conversation involved the Kennedy assassination, and Di ision as a motorcycle officer. MAJOR ELLIS stated he was in the motor_cade that day. His duty that day placed him as the left front motorcycle officer to the inmediate left front of the President's automobile. This officer went into great detail about the happenings preceding and

MAJOR ELLIS stated the motorcade had strung out and because immediately following Kennedy's assination. the police were trying to close up the President's car was going so slow it caused his motorcycle to wobble. He stated further that it became necessary to hold this motorcycle up by using his legs.

The most important point, I believe he mentioned were the

MAJOR ELLIS stated that to his left front near the curb dust happenings surrounding the first shot. flew or was kicked up about the same time he heard the first shot. He observed people in this immediate falling to the ground

The MAJOR stated he believed this was the first bullet and apparently to avoid any further shots. even now he was more convinced. This is because a portion of the curb where he saw the dust fly has been has been removed. This occurred only a few days after the assassination. The officer went on to state that instead of speeding up as per instructions the cars all slowed down when the shots were fired.

The second part of the conversation was about one of MAJOR ELLIS's fellow motorcycle officers. Thisofficer (as told by ELLTS) stated he was directly under the building when the shots. were fired. The Hocked the main entrance and after the supervisor arrived he started up the stairs. The building was the Book Depository. Upon going up the stairs, he and the superivsor encountered someone on either the third or fourth floor. This person was drinking water from the water cooler -- he did not stop because the supervisor advised the officer that the man was en employee. MAJOR ELLIS stated this officer later identified the man by the water cooler as LEE HARVEY OSWALD: This is a summation of the conversation.
