### Oswald's language skills

1. Director to SAC, Newark 1/7/'64 questions Degado's claim that he taught Oswald Spanish . . .
2. Check with BOT on Rankin's comments about Oswald going to Army Language school in Monterey
3. SAC, Miami to Dir 11/23/'63 reports that Oswald speaks Spanish. . . This from Bringuier
4. FBI report 11/27/'63 from a Camarata who served with Oswald in marines. . . Oswald rumored to speak Russian . . .
5. Report to FBIHQ quoting Delgado that Oswald spoke perfect Spanish . . .
6. Another guy who served with Oswald in marines and commented on his Russian language and things Russian
7. Delgado reinterviewed 1/16/1964 . . . two "soldiers" said he taught them simple Spanish . . . Phrases most likely. . .
8. 12/5/'64 from Anderson in MC notes that an Ernesto Rodriguez of NO gave Spanish lessons to Oswald. Do a name check on Rodriguez (DL FO Index)
9. Emory Brown's failure to get Defense Language Institute to admit that Oswald was ever a student. . . If I need to use this in conjunction with Rankin's Ex. Session comment that Oswald went there for Spanish. . . See BOT.
10. De Mohrenschildt WC testimony IX, p. 166 where De M stated that he and Oswald discussed Russian literature in Russian . . .
