## "I SAN THE PRESIDENT ASSASSIMATED"

I had escorted President Kennedy in 1961 when he came to Dallas to visit with Mr. Sam Rayburn who was in Baylor Hospital in serious condition. That day when we got back to Love Field Mr. Kennedy shock my hand and thanked me for the escort. This time I was hoping that I could escort the President again but I thought I would probably have to work a corner instead. In Detail I was assigned to ride on the right hand side and slightly to the rear of the Presidential Linousine. The original plan was to have two officers ride on the left of the car and two on the right of the car.
