I think Lonnie Hudkins is the one who wrote a story in a Houston paper about it.

I don't even remember that Rankin bad mouthed me, although he was there at the meeting we held in Washington. I don't believe anything productive came out of that hearing. I know I felt at the time that Carr was trying to get in on the assassination act, but was having trouble with his Court of Inquiry here.

I hope everything is going good with your book and although my memory is not as good as it used to be, I will try to answer anything you request if I can remember any of the details. I hope your health is better. Good luck to you.
