Doc. A "Silver Dollar" . . . Ref. to Texas State Troopers badge (possibly). . . Is a reference to Dallas PD Counterintelligence or Intelligence section . . . In short, probably Jack Revill's boss. . . I need to list the names of officers from this section . The ones who were in the Military Reserves in Counterintelligence. . . I should have this in my "JFK's Dallas Trip" . . . 112th Intelligence Group at Ft. Sam Houston, Texas. . .

Contact was made on 11/22/'63 to Deputy Chief of Staff Operations and Training (DCSO&T, HQ Fourth US Army. . . re: about an incoming civilian call to the "Silver Dollar" War Room. . . . called could be reached at Extension No. 2703. . . . The exchange could be interpreted as a "go ahead with the operation . . . a go forward with the assassination . . . The call came at 1225 hours (12:25 P.M. on 11/22)

I will need names of Revill's fellow officers (esp. his boss) who were all US Army reserves in Counterintelligence (I believe). . . Revill's boss was Assistant Chief Don Stringfellow, Intelligence Section, Dallas PD. . .

Doc. c in this collection 89-43-2381C 11/22. . . received 5:30 P.M. has Stringfellow claiming that Oswald confessed to the shooting of JFK and Tibbets Next request made for a Russian translator. . . +Name given but blanked out Best bet it was DeMohrenschild . . . and the other black out was probably FBI Bouhe(check w/ marina files) for correct spelling.
