Reference is made to a letter from this Bureau dated June 3, 1960, advising that subject, who had renounced his American citizenship at the United States Embassy, Moscow, Russia, on October 31, 1959, was expected to enter the Albert Schweitzer College in Switzerland on April 20, 1960,

Subsequent information received from a confidential source abroad indicates that subject never arrived at the above-name | College, although he had paid a \$25 deposit toward school fees. The College has not heard from subject since he sent this deposit in June, 1959, from an unknown address.

For your additional information, the Office of Naval Intelligence advised on November 15, 1960, that on August 17, 1960, subject was given an undesirable discharge from the United States Marine Corps Reserve and that his home address as of July 20, 1959, was 3124 West Fifth Street, Fort Worth, Texas,
