Shifts to the January 27<sup>th</sup> transcript. The transcript appears in Hal's Whitewash IV pp. 36-121. The page nos at upper right are the page nos of the transcript are those of the court reporter. . . It was Rankin who then told the Commissioners that (on p.2) that Oswald worked for the FBI was what was being carried in the press.

This is the bombshell transcript of January 11, 1964. . . the one in which evidence disclosed in the press that Oswald had ties to the FBI. . . . !!!!! How as the WC going to handle this?
