1. To Curry 12/9/'63 Notes that due to extreme mutilation it could not be determined whether Q188 (Walker bullet) came from K1 (Oswald's alleged rifle) or not. . .
  2. Jevons to Conrad, 5/14/'64 62-109060-8301X, Folder 14, Box 109, testimony on JFK's shirt. . . . All Frazier could say was that "all of the tested items were similar. . . ." He left for a more exact analysis and opinion to Gallagher. Was this covered in the Redlich/Gallagher exchange in September 1963?
  3. Sylvia Meagher's letter in Wash Post 6/18/1966 (A-10). . . makes criticism of WC for scattering the evidence in the case throughout the 26 volumes. . . Box 109). . .
  4. Jevons to Conrad 3/20/'64 62-109060-8301X RG 65 /all Box 109 Eisenberg wants FBI to have fire arms evidence transferred to Ronald Simmons at Aberdeen, MD for re-examination . . . Hoover flips out. . . .WC does not trust the vaunted FBI, etc, etc. . . Check my notes to the typed copy that showed good reason for skepticism . . . See following docs 6 & 7 & 8 for Rankin's efforts to smooth over w/ Hoover. . . Hoover remained pissed. . . But add reasons why the WC was suspect of FBI's handling of the evidence in the case. . . Add here at 10. That FBI just getting around to Chief Curry collecting the three other cartridges in the Tippit shooting. This was FBI Lab Reports to Chief Curry 3/30/'64.   5. FBI Lab report to James Rowley 12/5/'63, 62-109060-8301X-RG 65, Folder 7 Notes that bullet holes in the back of JFK's coat and shirt align at 5 3/8inches below the collar. (compatable with Dr. Burkley's JFK death certificate).

1A FBI to Curry 1/23/'63 62-109060-1694 This is the {"instant"} FBI analysis of the Dallas police. Read carefully. (This is the document that Weisberg mentions in his CA suit CA 1107

2A Hoover to Rankin March 24, 1964 Folder 23. Hoover explains the windshield of the presidential limo . . .

3A. Conrad to Jevons 3/6/'64 Results as defined by FBI that the NAA testing at Oakridge resulted in no discernible conclusions. . . .This is the FBI party line that Gallagher will peddle to Redlich when he was deposed. . . Folder 22.

4A Jevons to Conrad 2/27/'64 \*\*\*\*\*Key. Important> They note that until this time the AEC testing as always on handgun testing with NAA. . .Testing w/ rifles(that is, Mannlicher/Carcanos) the blowback was great and even after washing the paraffin casts. 7A Hoover to Rankin 3/23/'64 Folder 22 Hoover trying to square the circle and make case for the holes in JFK's clothes being bullet holes. . . .This is key \*\*\*\* for me because he includes the JFK's shirt collar and tie.

8A Ryan to Bailey 6/1/'79 This underscores the problem of Guinn's HSCA testimony . . . . This was precipitated by Jerry Polkoff's piece in Gallery. See attached. \*\*\*

9A FBI Lab to Curry 12/6/'63 Folder 21 Results on the Walker bullet (Q 188) cannot make match with Oswald's rifle. . .

2B FBI Lab to Rowley 12/5/'63 JFK's clothes. P. 2 \*\*\*\* Note at this date it is described as a "nick" in the left side of the knot of the tie." Note: This will change to a hole when Frazier testifies before the WC . . .\*\*\*\* Folder 7

3B FBI Lab report that says EXPIDITE. . . the FBI requested exam 3/14/'64 > The FBI never bothered with these three bullets taken from Tippit. . . Folder 7.

4B Collection of FBI memos on the Warren Report. . .\*\*\*\* Read w/ use of chapter from BOT on the FBI's War Against the Commission as possible chapter.
