USA H. BAREFOOT SANDERS telephonically advised that he had received radio and TV reports that Assistant District Attorney ALEXANDER had made release that he was filing complaint against LEE HARVEY OSWALD for murder of the President, and wide Communistic conspiracy. USA SANDERS pointed out the wide political implications in this matter and stated he is contacting District Attorney WADE, however, should ALEXANDER draw up a complaint and it was signed by Chief CURRY or Captain FRITZ, ALEXANDER would be free to continue.

This information was furnished to Chief CURRY by SAC SHANKLIN and he was advised that such complaint would not be signed.

In addition USA advised that he had been contacted by a pathologist from the University, who advised that he had heard the information the individual who shot the President had been eating chicken and the bones were lying near the window where the President was shot. This pathologist advised that if the voids of the suspect were retained, a pathologist could determine if chicken had been eaten.

This information was passed on to Chief CURRY and he advised the necessary precautions to preserve the voids of the suspect would be taken.
