

The Katzenbach memo lays out the "official truth" of Dallas. What is that "official truth"?

The Katzenbach memo was written and prepared after his 'discussion' with the 'director' and as it turned out, curiously, these would be the results of the FBI investigation. Katzenbach stated that the results of the FBI investigation should be put out to the public by the end of the week in order to assure and satisfy the public that this was a one person assassination and not the result of a communist plot.
