ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963 DALLAS, TEXAS

The body of the President was immediately taken to the Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Maryland, for autopsy... An autopsy was performed which was witnessed by three Service Agents, two Bureau Agents, and attending physicians.

The Secret Service has advised our Baltimore Office that graphs of the autopsy and X-rays of the President's body available to us through Secret Service Headquarters, Washington

RECOMMENDED:

It is not recommended that we request these photographs through the Secret Service Headquarters at this time as it appears we shall have need for this material. In the event a need develops in the future, this material will be available at Secret Service Headquarters.
