By letter dated January 11, 1964, J. D. ROYCE,
496 West Scott Avenue, Clovis, California, advised Parade
Publications, Inc., New York, New York, that he had what he
believed to be "positive proof that LEE HARVEY OSWALD did not
assassinate the President of the United States."

On January 23, 1964, J. D. ROYCE advised Special
Agents of the FBI that the "positive proof" he referred to in
the above-mentioned letter was based entirely on a double-page
photograph which appeared on Pages 24 - 25 of the December 14,
1963, edition of the Saturday Evening Post. He stated that
after examining this photograph with a magnifying glass, which
photograph was reported to have been taken the instant President
KENNEDY was shot, he was convinced that the individual standing
in the background in the left edge of the doorway was OSWALD.
