Subj: Request for information concerning former Lance Corporal
 Nelson DELGADO, 1644884, USMC

Information from the service record of the subject-named
 man is furnished as requested by reference (a).

Lance Corporal Nelson Delgado enlisted in the regular
 Marine Corps on 26 November 1956 for a period of three years. He
 was released from active duty on 25 November 1959, by reason of
 expiration of enlistment, and was transferred to the Marine Corps
 Reserve to complete his service obligation. He was honorably dis-
 charged on 1 November 1960 by reason of enlistment in the regular
 Army.

Delgado was attached to Marine Air Control Squadron-9,
 Marine Corps Air Facility, Santa Ana, California, from 4 September
 1957 to 11 November 1959. From 12 November 1959 to 25 November
 1959, he was attached to Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron,
 Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro, California, awaiting release
 from active duty. During the period 1 June 1958 through 25 November
 1959, he was on leave from 27 December 1958 to 23 January 1959,
 and from 22 September 1959 to 25 September 1959.

Delgado fired the M-1 rifle on the "A" Course at Parris
 Island, South Carolina, on 11 January 1957. He attained a score
 of 201, which qualified him to wear the marksman badge. On 20 March
 1958, he fired the M-1 rifle on the "B" Course at Marine Corps Air
 Station, El Toro, California, and attained a score of 220. This
 entitled him to the sharpshooter badge. The "A" Course has a maxi-
 mum range of 500 yards; the "B" Course has a maximum range of 200
 yards. Qualification scores on both ranges are as follows:
