Delgado says he was one of 5  
Merins who walked off regularly  
with no pot (p. 26)

questioned by FBI 4 times

p. 27 Delgado makes argument that  
there was no way a score could be  
fixed when Merins went into  
what he called "~~live firing~~

Could Oswald have succeeded in his

by Kiebler — Delgado says —  
p. 34 He may have but "if you  
got away with it you were very lucky."  
Delgado ~~may~~ told FBI that KHO  
may have done this "because he  
there was a lot of Heggie's brass on
