Reference is made to memo Mr. C. D. DeLoach to Mr. Mohr dated 11/23/63, setting forth information received from Robert Manning, Assistant Secretary of State for Public Affairs, who advised that a Foreign Service Officer named John Victor McVickar, dealt with Oswald when Oswald attempted to turn in his U. S. passport and gain Russian citizenship.

At 2:35 p. m., 11/23/63, John Shay, Duty Agent, WFO, was instructed to arrange interview of McVickar concerning his knowledge of Oswald. Interview to be conducted this date.

USSR
SAC Gillies, WFO, subsequently advised that Jack Lynch, Security Officer, State Department, had advised that one Priscilla Johnston and Mrs. G. Stanley Brown also had contact with Oswald in Russia. Both these women were formerly State Department employees at the American Embassy and their contact with Oswald was official business.

According to Gillies, Priscilla Johnston is no longer with the State Department and now reportedly resides at Cambridge, Massachusetts, no further address available. Mrs. G. Stanley Brown now resides at Alexandria, Virginia, and her home telephone number is 768-2472.

ACTION:

WFO is now arranging for interview of McVickar and leads are being set forth by WFO to interview Johnston and Brown concerning their knowledge of Oswald.
