Although the file does not reflect this, it has been established that on December 23, 1963 Orrin Bartlett, FBI Liaison Officer, requested and was furnished a copy of the autopsy report.

There has also been the question as to the date on which the Secret Service furnished the autopsy report to the Warren Commission. A review of our files has failed to establish this date, probably because of the manner in which the autopsy report was held in a confidential envelope.
