Howley that our Dallas Cylice was already in contact with the Secret Service in Pallas and that we would render every possible assistance. I mentioned that one of the fecret Ferrice agents reportedly had been killed, and he stated he did not know this. I told him I had asked the name of the Secret Service Agent killed but it was not known. I told Mr. Her ley that apparently the shooting came from the fourth floor of a building and shells had been found in the building, that these were Winchester shells - experently a Winchester rille was mood; and that the building was surrounded. Mr. Rowley stated be was also thinking of subversive elements - Afexico and Cuba. I then mentioned the Klan element. I advised Mr. Rowley that one aliness stated he saw a Negro man loan out a window but later this was act confirmed and they do not know whether it was a white or a black. -I told his.
