RE TEL CALL FROM BUREAU TO DALLAS, DEC. TWELVE LAST.

FORMER SHERIFF STEVE GUTHRIE, DALLAS, TEXAS, ADVISED THE FBI THAT DALLAS
HE UNDERSTOOD MAYOR EARLE CABELL OR CITY MANAGER ELGIN CRULL HAD TEXAS
ORDERED CHIEF JESSE E. CURRY TO BRING LEE HARVEY OSWALD OUT OF
THE CITY JAIL DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS FOR BENEFIT OF TV CAMERAS.

ON DEC. TWELVE LAST, MAYOR CABELL, DALLAS, INFORMED HIS
OFFICE IS A POLICY OFFICE AND NOT ADMINISTRATIVE AND, THEREFORE,
AT NO TIME DID HE GIVE ANY INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING REMOVAL OF
OSWALD AND MADE NO COMMENT TO PRESS CONCERNING OSWALD/S REMOVAL.
HE SAID HE WAS NOT PRESENT AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, DALLAS, ON
NOV. TWENTYTWO THROUGH TWENTYSIX LAST. MAYOR CABELL SAID HE HAD
NO KNOWLEDGE THAT THE POLICE HAD RECEIVED A THREAT ON OSWALD/S
LIFE. HE ADVISED CHIEF CURRY CALLED HIM AT HIS HOME IMMEDIATELY
AFTER OSWALD WAS SHOT.
