SHOOTING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD, 11/24/63.

At 12:15 P.M., Inspector JAMES HANLEY, Washington, D.C., stated that the Director had received a call from President JOHNSON, and he has instructed that we are to interview JACK LEON RUBY and be in on the interview and to keep the Bureau fully advised. Inspector HANLEY advised President JOHNSON is very concerned; that we are looking ridiculous in the eyes of the world when we are not in a position to protect a man who is in custody of the Police Department. *LBJ had to be relieved - WHO's death - case closed*

I contacted SA HALL and furnished information and told him to insure that our Agent would be in on the interview and to immediately notify me. The Bureau also pointed out that we should make arrangements to make certain that if there is a dying declaration from subject LEE HARVEY OSWALD that we take advantage of it.
