Re telephone call from Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY, Bureau, to SAC J. GORDON SHAWKLIN, Dallas.

Assistant Chief of Police, CHARLES E. BATCHELOR, Dallas, PD, this date advised SA VINCENT E. DRAIN that Inspector J. H. SAWYER, of the Dallas/PD, was one of the first officers to arrive at the scene of the Texas School Book Depository (TSBD) building, 411 Elm Street. An unidentified individual told Inspector SAWYER that he had seen an individual run from the TSBD building shortly after the shooting of President KENNEDY and that this individual was an unknown white male, approximately 30, slender build, 5'10", 155 pounds, carrying what looked to be a 30:30, or some type of Winchester rifle. Inspector SAWYER then contacted Dallas Police Sergeant G. D. HENSLEE, Radio Dispatcher, and this description was broadcast to all Dallas squad cars. SAWYER did not get the individual's name who furnished this information, and from affidavits taken subsequently of individuals who were near the scene at the time of the shooting, no identification has been made of the source of this information.
