12:45 (CST). . . . That's about 15 minutes after the shooting Dallas Police Inspector J.H. Sawyer (a 23-year veteran on the force) was on the police radio w/ a description of the shooter. (source: 105-82555-1354 (S. 64).

He was a white male, approximately 30 years old, slender build 5ft 10 inches, and about 165 pounds. And he had a rifle that looked like a 30, 30 type of Winchester. No description of what he was wearing. (Interesting).

When questioned about the witness Sawyer (a 23-year veteran police officer) never got the source's name. {I have the reason for this I think).

[Recall that Oswald was 24 years old; he weighed 131 at time of his death (according to Dr. Rose's autopsy report) and he was 5' 9" inches in height.

What is interesting about this is that the CIA had at least three files on Oswald in 1963. One of them under the name of Lee HENRY Oswald with vitals: 30 years old, 5'10" and weighing 165 pounds. [Note to myself I want to cite Bill Simpich].

I believe the first newsman to introduce the assassin to the American public was [the iconic] Walter Cronkite and he called him "Lee Henry Oswald."

(I think David Kaiser was the first to point this out about Cronkite.
