BUELL WESLEY FRAZIER, white male, age 19, residence 2435 West Fisth Street, Irving, Texas, was interviewed concerning his association with LEE HARVEY OSWALD. FRAZIER advised he is presently employed at the Texas School Book Depository located at the corner of Elmand Houston Streets in Dallas and has been so employed there since September 13, 1963. He advised he resides at the residence of his sister, LENNIE MAE RANDLE at 2515 West Fifth Street, Irving, Texas. In regard to his association and meeting of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, he advised as follows:

Approximately one month ago as he surmised, his sister was having coffee with RUTH PAINE and OSWALD's wife at his sister's house in Grand Prairie. At that time his sister mentioned that he, FRAZIER, was employed at the . Texas School Book Depository and RUTH PAINE made inquiries as to possible employment for LEE HARVEY OSWALD. As he understood, about that same day, PAINE called the Texas School Book Depository to see about obtaining a job for LEE OSWALD which he believed to be on a Friday and the following Monday, OSWALD started work at the Texas School Book Depository. He advised he had ascertained over the weekend from his sister, EENNIS MAE RANDLE, that OSWALD had obtained employment. Subsequently, the following Monday morning, when he got to work, he introduced himself to LEE OSWALD at which time OSWALD told FRAZIER he had an apartment in the Oak Cliff section of Dallas. At that time they discussed OSWALD riding in FRAZIER's vehicle at which time OSWALD told FRAZIER he would like to ride home with him on Friday evenings to Irving and return. to work with him in Dallas on Monday mornings. FRAZIER agreed with this arrangement and subsequently drove OSWALD on the weekends from his place of employment to his wife's residence in Irving, and returned him to work on Monday mornings.

He advised during the day of November 21, 1963, OSWALD had approached him at work and requested that he be able to ride with FRAZIER to Irving as he wanted to obtain some curtain rods for his residence, in Dallas.
