FROM : Allen W. Dulles

There is one point which I feel we should deal with in Chapter VII, Motivation: namely, the so-called hate motive from both left and right including possibly some ~~left~~ ^{reference} to the so-called "Spirit of Dallas."

This has been so propagandized, particularly abroad, and I feel so widely credited that I do not feel that we should ignore it. A discussion of this point would fit into our chapter on motivation after the discussion of Castro's Cuba and communism as a motivating influence.
