Attached is a memorandum setting forth a theory as to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy advanced by Mr. Wilton J. Lutwack, President of Colad Company, Incorporated, of Buffalo, New York. Mr. Lutwack, who specifically asked that his name not be mentioned, requested that this theory be brought to the attention of Chief Justice Earl Warren, expressing his belief that it would be supported by George H. Estabrooks and other leading experts in the field of hypnotism.
