Shop mounted a scope on a rifle three weeks before the assassination.

Commission Finding: The manager of the Irving Sport Shop has stated that his shop mounted a scope on a rifle for someone named Oswald about three weeks before the assassination. However, he does not remember ever having worked on a Mannlicher-Carcano rifle.

Allegation: An amateur photograph, 8 mm, taken 10 minutes before the assassination of President Kennedy at 12:20 p.m. showed two silhouettes at the sixth floor window.

Commission Finding: A film taken by an amateur photographer at 12:30 shows a shadow in the sixth floor window. This has been determined after examination by the FBI to be the shadow from Drumen in the cartons near the window.
