DALLAS POLICE FILES REFLECT GENERAL EDWIN A. WALKER ON APRIL TEN SIXTYTHREE AT NINE TEN PM REPORTED THAT ABOUT NINE PM THAT DATE HE WAS SITTING AT A DESK IN HIS HOME, FOUR ZERO ONE ONE TURTLE CREEK BOULEVARD, DALLAS, TEXAS, WHEN SHOT WAS FIRED INFO HIS HOME ABOVE HIS HEAD INTO THE ROOM WHERE HE WAS SITTING. CAPTAIN O. A. JONES AND LIEUTENANT E. L.
