

Synopsis:

GEORGE GREGORY BURKLEY, a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh Medical School, was a medical fellow from 7/1/29 to 7/1/32 at the Mayo Graduate School of Medicine (Mayo Clinic), Rochester, Minnesota. He majored in medicine with a minor in pathology and had a good record. No credit record or arrest record located at Rochester, Minnesota.

DETAILS:

Graduate School of Medicine, an adjunct of the University of Minnesota Graduate School and formerly known as the Mayo Foundation (Mayo Clinic), Rochester, Minnesota on November 13, 1964 advised as follows from records of her

GEORGE GREGORY BURKLEY, was born August 29, 1902 at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and graduated from South Hill High School, Pittsburgh. From 1922 to 1924 he attended the University of Pittsburgh and from 1924 to 1928 he attended the University of Pittsburgh where he received his Masters Degree. From July 1928 to July 1929 he interned at St. Francis Hospital, Pittsburgh.

## MP 161-245

Doctor BURKLEY was a medical fellow at the former Mayo Foundation, Kochester, Minnesota from July 1, 1929 to July 1, 1932 when he completed his three year fellowship. His major at Mayo was in medicine with a minor in pathology. The comments made concerning Doctor BURKLEY by Mayo staff members at the time, described his work there as very good. There is nothing in the record that is other than favorable concerning Doctor BURKLEY.

Bureau Rochester, Minnesota on November 12, 1964 stated GEORGE GREGORY BURKLEY's name is not on file in that office.

Police Department and Records Office, Rochester Office, both Rochester, Minnesota on November 12, 1964 stated Doctor BURKLEY's name is not listed in the arrest records of their respective offices.
