2. A called me this morning at the office to thank me
for my assistance in the investigation.

3. A advised that C was not in evidence
following the assassination of Martin Luther KING on Thursday,
4 April 1968. A received word from a reliable source that
A C, who is under Peking discipline, was instructed not to be
in the forefront.

~~-----~~ and others referred in the Black Power structure who are under ~~re~~ discipline will hold a strategy meeting in the Reverend KING's home after the funeral.

3. A suggested that A will disclose that ABC and ABC will be in the forefront during the funeral services. According to ABC has sufficient information of a blackmail nature on TCC that will result in TCC reacting as a puppet to Peking direction in the coming presidential nominating campaign. A urged that a task force be established not by the FPI but by the intelligence community to cover S from now on in which should develop the intelligence that C, Partin Luther KING, and C have for years been the willing tools of Peking.
