MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Security Research Staff

SUBJECT: A - REPORT FROM

1. A called me this morning at the office to thank me

2. A advised that C was not in evidence following the assassination of Martin Luther KING on Thursday, 4 April 1968. A received word from a reliable source that AAC, who is under Peking discipline, was instructed not to be in the forefront.

AAC and other leaders in the Black Power structure who are under Peking discipline will hold a strategy meeting in the Reverend KING's home after the funeral.

3. A suggested that A will disclose that AAC and AAC will be in the forefront during the funeral services. According to AAC has sufficient information of a blackmail nature on C that will result in C reacting as a puppet to Peking direction in the coming presidential nominating campaign. A urges that a task force be established not by the FBI but by the intelligence community to cover SSA from now on in which should develop the intelligence that SSA, Martin Luther KING, and C have for years been the willing tools of Peking.
