Unfounded Allegations Regarding a KGB Terrorist School

1. Reference is made to a memorandum, dated 16 June 1964, concerning certain allegations made by a contact

A copy of that memorandum has been furnished to this Staff and will be included in the appropriate file.

- 2. We have these comments concerning the allegations:
  - a. Marina OSWALD is a native of Archangelsk, not of Minsk.
  - b. The trial of BANDERA's assassin did not V bring out information about the assassin's attendance at a KGB "terrorist special operations school in Minsk. USSR". We have no evidence that the assassin ever attended a "terrorist school" anywhere, nor is there any indication that he was ever in Minsk.
  - c. At the trial BANDERA's assassin admitted that he received basic tradecraft training and inductrination in a KGB school in Kiev. (Our information shows that there has been no Soviet State Security (now KGB) school in Minak since 1947.)
