Still tat means that this executive body was not in session from June 4th until several weeks after Labor Day when, once again, the Warren Commission Report was being drafted. If I am correct, it means that the Commission staff possibly under the solo guidance of Chief Counsel Rankin was doing all the heavy lifting.

I thought I had better write just to confirm this observation. I would be most appreciative if you could find the staff time to simply send me the dates of the Commission's executive session that are housed at the Archives.

I also want to thank you for all of your prompt responses to my previous communications. I have a book just coming out on Dr. King and the FBI and after working with the Bureau's FOIA section for the past 10 years I am delighted with the turnaround time I have experienced with the College Park archives.
