REBUTEL JUNE SEVENTEEN REQUESTING PERTINENT INFORMATION CONCERNING ALLEGATIONS IN BOOK "THE RED ROSES OF DALLAS" BY MERIN E. GUN.

JUNE EIGHTEEN LAST J. E. "BILL" DECKER, SHERIFF, DALLAS COUNTY, TEX, MADE AVAILABLE REPORT OF DEPUTY SHERIFF BUDDY WALTHERS DATED NOV TWENTYSECOND, SIXTYTHREE, REFLECTING RESULTS OF HIS INVESTIGATION IN REGARD TO THE ASSASSINATION. SAID REPORT, ACCORDING TO SHERIFF DECKER, HAS BEEN FURNISHED TO PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION.

THIS REPORT MAKES NO MENTION THAT ONE SHOT WAS FIRED FROM THE RAILWAY OVERPASS IN FRONT OF THE MOTORCADE. IT ALSO MAKES NO MENTION OF WALTHERS ALONG WITH A SECRET SERVICE AGENT FINDING IN THE GRASS NEAR THE BRIDGE "THE FOURTH BULLET."

WALTHERS WAS, AS REFLECTED IN HIS REPORT, AT THE TEXAS THEATRE AT THE TIME OF OSWALD'S ARREST.

JUNE EIGHTEEN, EDDIE RAYMOND "BUDDY" WALTHERS WAS INTERVIEWED, AND STATED HE HAD NEVER HEARD OF THE BOOK "THE RED ROSES OF DALLAS" BY MERIN E. GUN AND DOES NOT KNOW ANYONE BY THAT NAME, AND HAS NEVER BEEN INTERVIEWED BY HIM.

WALTHERS STATED HE MADE NO STATEMENT WHATSOEVER TO ANYONE THAT ONE OF THE SHOTS WAS FIRED FROM THE RAILROAD OVERPASS AND HAD ACTUALLY CONCLUDED AT THE TIME THAT ALL SHOTS HAD COME FROM THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY BUILDING.

WALTHERS STATED HE DID NOT WORK WITH ANY SECRET SERVICE AGENT IN THE INVESTIGATION OF THE ASSASSINATION AND THAT SINCE HE HEARD ONLY THREE SHOTS HE WOULD HAVE HAD NO REASON TO LOOK FOR A FOURTH BULLET OR EMPTY CARTRIDGE CASE. HE STATED HE NEVER LOOKED FOR A FOURTH BULLET NOR DID HE FIND A FOURTH BULLET AND DID NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY SEARCH FOR A BULLET WITH ANY SECRET SERVICE AGENT.

WALTHERS STATED HE HAS NO IDEA WHERE GUN GOT THE INFORMATION WHICH IS ATTRIBUTED TO HIM.

INFORMATION REFLECTED ON PAGE FOUR ONE ZERO, REPORT OF SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING, DALLAS, DATED NOV THIRTY, SIXTYTHREE, REFLECTS THAT THE RECORDS OF PARKLAND MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, DALLAS, NOV. TWENTYFIVE, SIXTYTHREE, REFLECTED A REPORT OF EMERGENCY CASE NO. 48LS1 DATED APRIL EIGHTEEN, FORTYFIVE, REFLECTING THAT LEE OSWALD, FOUR EIGHT ZERO ONE VICTOR, DALLAS, AT AGE FIVE, WAS TREATED FOR AN INJURY SUSTAINED WHEN HE WAS HIT IN THE LEFT EYE BY A ROCK. HE WAS TREATED WITH ICE PACKS AND DISCHARGED ON APR NINETSENTH, FORTYFIVE. NO RECONTACT BEING HAD WITH PARKLAND MEMORIAL HOSPITAL UACB.
