Dear Mr. Hoover :

I understand that the F.B.I. investigation of the Kennedy assassination does not reach the same conclusions as the Warren Commission's report. I am curious to know how the F.B.I. Summary Report differs from the Warren Report. Also, has it ever been established if James Ray, a bystander during the incident, was hit by the assassin's bullets or fragments of a bullet?

I wish some information also on the following subject. At the University of Florida, where I am a student, there are several organizations which I feel are left wing groups. The one that appears most prominent on the campus is the Students for a Democratic Society (S.D.S.). I have often wondered if this is a Communist oriented group and if they are on the F.B.I. list of subversive organizations.

With my admiration and respect for you and your organization, I feel your answers to my questions are the "final word" on those subjects.

To a man whose name and organization are household words held in the highest esteem by the American public, I want to say, thank you, Mr. Hoover, for helping to make and keep our country safe and free America. I pray that you will continue to direct and lead the Federal Bureau of Investigation for many years to come.
