1. W. G. Lawson's report on the advance team of SS agents who went to Texas in preparation of JFK's visit. All very routine in scope.
2. Lawson's Final Survey report to Rowley on JFK's visit to Texas. See page 9 for Protective Research materials.
3. A batch of what I call SS threat assessments to the president from Dallas, Houston, El Paso, and San Antonio. These to be reviewed in context of the Hosty threat that was not reported. How would SS have responded is based on how they responded to threats that were of less potential.
