SUBJECT: [redacted] Comments on the Kennedy Assassination

USSR U.S. Austria

1. Attached for your perusal are the written comments of [redacted] defector [redacted] on some aspects of the assassination [S] of President John F. Kennedy. As you know, [redacted] defected [S] [redacted] about ten years ago, and his personal knowledge is not up to date, but he has stayed in touch with Soviet intelligence developments to the best of his ability. His comments on how Lee OSWALD and his wife must have been handled by Soviet intelligence authorities while they were inside the Soviet Union are particularly interesting and his suggestions for the questioning of Mrs. Marina OSWALD are equally provocative.

2. We have decided to pass on his views without editing, and this Agency does not specifically endorse his conclusions or recommendations.
