BY SECRET MEMORANDUM TO AMBASSADOR DATED OCTOBER 16 LAST, COPY TO THIS OFFICE WHICH COPY WAS RECEIVED OCTOBER 18 LAST [CIA] ADVISED AS FOLLOWS:

"1. THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED FROM A [redacted] SOURCE ON 1 OCTOBER 1963, AN AMERICAN MALE CONTACTED THE SOVIET EMBASSY AND IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS LEE OSWALD. THIS OFFICE DETERMINED THAT OSWALD HAD BEEN AT THE SOVIET EMBASSY ON 28 SEPTEMBER 1963 AND HAD TALKED WITH VALERIY VLADIMIRIVICH KOSTIKOV, A MEMBER OF THE CONSULAR SECTION, IN ORDER TO LEARN IF THE SOVIET EMBASSY HAD RECEIVED A REPLY FROM WASHINGTON CONCERNING HIS REQUEST. WE HAVE NO CLARIFYING INFORMATION WITH REGARD TO THIS REQUEST.

2. OUR HEADQUARTERS HAS INFORMED US THAT THE OSWALD ABOVE IS PROBABLY IDENTICAL WITH LEE HENRY OSWALD, BORN ON 18 OCTOBER 1939 IN NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA, A FORMER RADAR OPERATOR IN THE U.S. MARINE CORPS WHO DEFECTED TO THE SOVIET UNION IN OCTOBER 1959.

3. THIS OFFICE WILL ADVISE YOU IF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THIS MATTER IS RECEIVED."

ON OCTOBER 18 CABLE SENT BUREAU UNDER CAPTION "LEE OSWALD, IS - R" FURNISHED BUREAU SUBSTANCE OF [CIA] MEMORANDUM AND REQUESTED BACKGROUND DATA. BUCAB OF OCTOBER 22 FURNISHED SUCH DATA.
