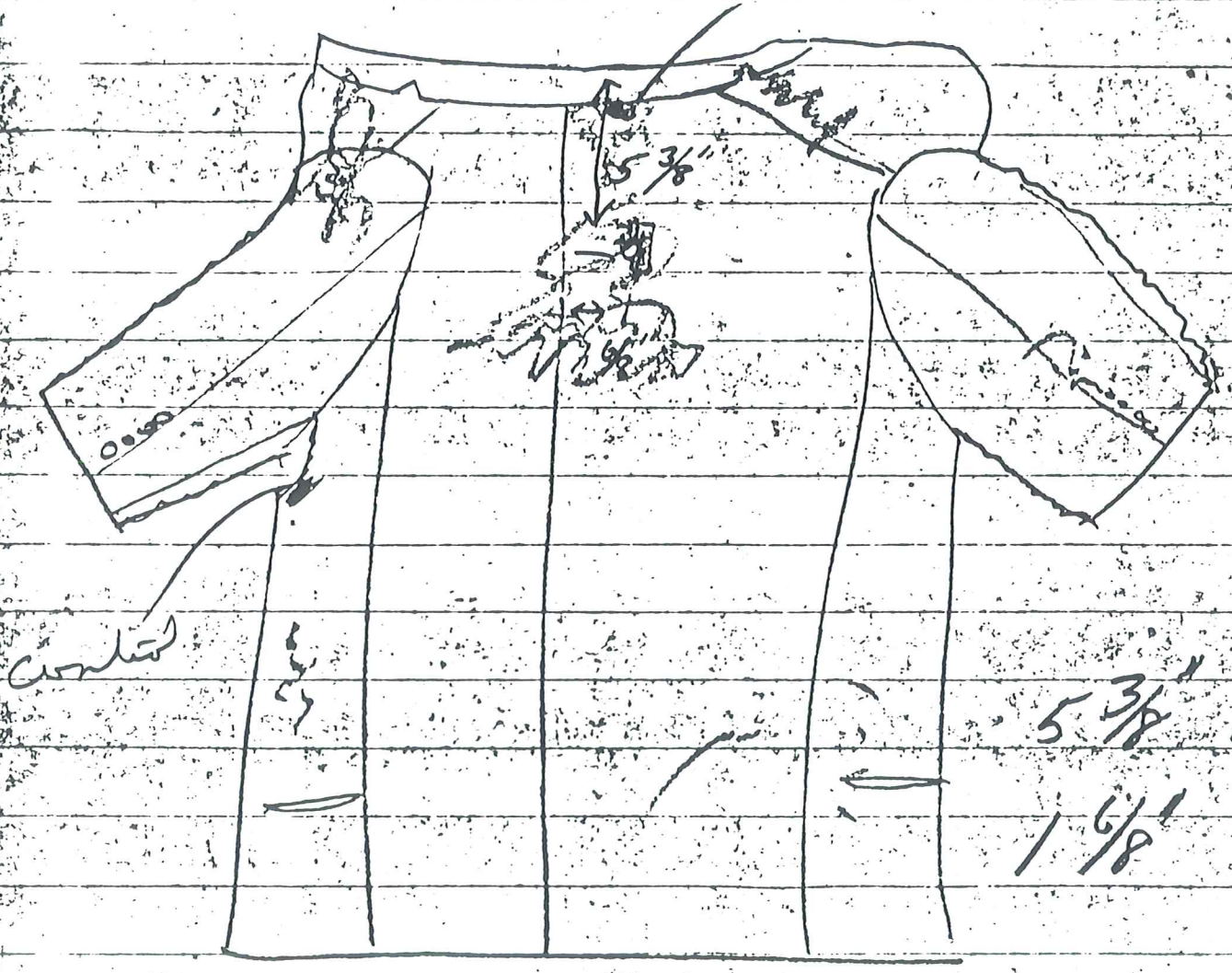

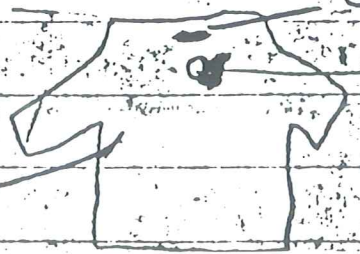

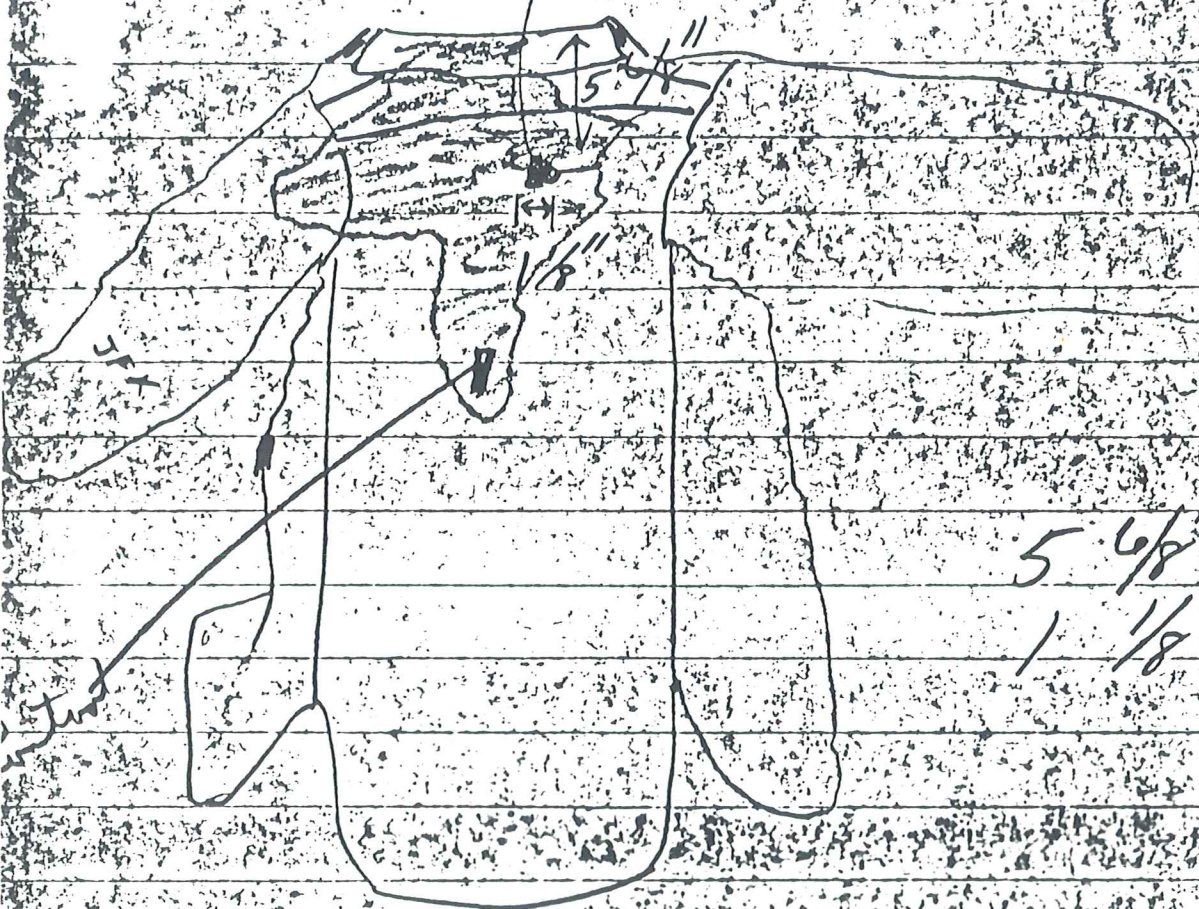

The fabric surrounding the hole in the back of the Q-22 coat and the fabric surrounding the hole in the back of the Q-25 shirt were spectrographically examined. Foreign traces of copper were found. This copper could have been deposited by a copper coated bullet penetrating the cloth of these garments. It is to be noted that the bullets involved in this case are copper coated.

The fabric surrounding the hole in the knot of the Q-24 necktie and the fabric surrounding the ~~hole~~ hole on the <sup>front of the</sup> neckband of the Q-25 shirt were also spectrographically examined. No significant deposits of metal were found in these pieces of fabric.
