- 3. Make point in Chpt. III bout WC's dependence on the FBI. This was made clear in January 22 Ex Sess. They could not offend Hoover because the FBI was doing all the investigation and laboratory work. And the Model. Use appropriate quotes from the January 22 meeting. The Commission was boxed in. The FbI does not "evaluate." But in its CD 1 and leaks it had come to an iron-clad conclusion that LHO was the killer. Iot did this even before it ran out all its Mexico leads that could spell a conspiracy. All this rfeflected in the tentative 1/11/'64 outline for the Commission's work. The Commission was ready to fold up and quit already; go thu the motions. See Epstein on this and the staffs' attitudes.
