Recent books and magazine articles challenging the conclusions of the Warren Commission are "a deception of the American people," attorney Albert E. Jenner says. He was senior counsel of the Warren Commission's investigation into the assessination of President Kennedy.

"I regard these books as mischievous and irresponsible and a discredit to the memory of Mr. Kennedy."

"The read all these books and checked them against the 26! volumes of the commission report," he said in an interview. "I find answers for all the questions that are raised."

Tenner said the critical works published since the report was issued have produced no new evidence that a second assassin was involved. He was joined in his assertion by two other key agures in the investigation.
