Note: These GS files do contain some useful correspondence with principles like Tink Thompson. (see one tha deals w/ Arnoni and ref. to his sleazy finances and personal dishonesty when it came to business. These should not be ignored.)

Folder: Meagher: To Editors, Press & Periodicals (1968-1969)

Re: Important source containing SM's responses to critics of the critics. For ex. one on Truman Capote who upheld the WCR and reveals his total ignorance of the case & the 26 vols. (Capote apparantly later retracted his unalloyed support of the WCR).

Need to review

Folder: General Correspondence, 1971

Re: contains some stuff on C. Wecht and FOIA request to see JFK autopsy pictures and x-rays. Also SM differs with HW on just how innocent the Kennedy family was in terms of the autopsy materials and general availability. Might want to check this out in the special Weisberg/SM corresp.

Folder: "40-Page article" titled: "WCR: Let the Reader Beware." A critique by SM, dated Nov. 1964. This may have been her maiden voyage in the JFK case? Returns seem to eb mostly rejections--New Yorker, New Leader, etc.

File: Proably file under SM's writings/reviews/ criticisms, etc.

Folder: Meagher: Radio, TV- (1965-1967)

Re: Some requests for SM as subject matter expert for radio and TV shows. One was a TV docudrama entitled "Trial of LHO"

Folder: Meagher to Editors, Press, and Periodicals (1965-1967)

Re: Review. See above instruction
