Re: George Renner(1968-1971)

SM to GR, August 19, 1967

Re: SM's goal . . ."I agree . . . that the Wr must be discredited on its own merits and my book, subject index, and articles have been directed toward that very objective."

SM then expands upon a synthesis by Renner on her criticism of the Garrison case. S M adds four points to his synthesis(This would be worth a review).

Re: SM gloating over the general wreckage left by the Garrison case as it was thrown out of court(Garrison v. Shaw case).

Re: Note on Ed. Epstein. Clear where Epstein stands on the WR & the Establishment--"as an accessory to its non-Truth." reference here made to Epstein's defense of WR in NY Times (Sunday, 4/20/'69).

SM to GR, May 24, 1969

Re: Discussion of Wm. Turner and a scathing assessment of the work of Paris Flammonde.

SM notes she knows of no evidence of any fed. repression of any work on the dissent of the WR. She mentions she also wrote a negative review of Flammonde's book.
