Re: Richard E. Sprague (1967-1968) Much of the corres. in this folder revolves around Sprague's work onm the photographs of the Daley Plaza. His work evolves into more elaborate deatil over the year.,

R.S. Oct. 15, 1967 (Exhibit # 2) Re: RS's analysis of photographs. Attached in an inventory of 386 photos itemized on an 11-page list of the photos. SP notes that WC used only 21 of the 386 photos(about 6%) and the FBI looked at about 50-60% of photos were examined.

Thomas Stamm (1965-1970)

Re: Stamm folder of some interest because of his essays andf their snappy titles. Where they ever published? No indication? He seemed to circulate copies to Meagher and others among the critics.

Thomas Stamm (1975-1977)

Re: Mostly Stamm's letters and several of his "essays." Little by way of SM correspondence. Stamm's "thing" was to criticize the published works of the critics. . . He was interested in the political motives behind the assassination; or, as he insisted, the historic contecxt. But he did no research of his own; he was a self-possessed "deep thinker."

Re: Corres. mostly about SM's review of 4 books on the assassination. I have copy of review in file; also a carbon copy of her review in folder. Also a sharp letter to editor of SOL for failure to notify her when the review came out.

Re: "Sunday Meeting" 10/3/'65

Re: transcript of meeting of the "Warrentologists." Apparantly there was only this one meeting. Many of the worthies were present. Folder also contains some '65 corres. with Epstein.
