REPORTED FRAGMENT FROM THIGH OF GOVERNOR CONNALI RE TELEPHONE CALL OF MR. FREEMAN, FBI LAB, TO SAC, DALLAS AT TEN FORTY FIVE PM., NOVEMBER TWENTYSEVEN, SIXTYTHREE.

ON NOVEMBER TWENTYTHREE, SIXTYTHREE DR. CHARLES FRANCIS GREGORY, PARKLAND HOSPITAL, STATED HE AND DR. TOM SHIRES AND OTHERS PERFORMED SURGERY ON GOVERNOR JOHN CONNALLY ON NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, LAST. DR. GREGORY FURNISHED A METAL FRAGMENT TAKEN FROM RIGHT ARM OF GOVERNOR CONNALLY AND SAME HAS BEEN FORWARDED TO LAB FOR APPROPRIATE COMPARISONS.

DR. GREGORY WAS ASKED WHETHER OR NOT HE REMOVED OR SAW REMOVED A SMALL FRAGMENT OF METAL FROM THE LEFT THIGH OF GOVERNOR CONNALLY AND HE STATED THAT ALTHOUGH XRAYS INDICATED THE POSSIBILITY OF A SMALL FRAGMENT OF METAL IMBEDDED IN THE LEFT THIGH. NO SURGERY WAS PERFORMED TO REMOVE SAME.
