Rankin was frustrated by Speaker (Wright) for unless he had access to the notes & by he could not justify his brief report for such one with any confidence.

Speaker to Rankin, "Autopsy Photographs and X-Ray of Head of John F. Kennedy," March 30, 1964
(JFK ~~Medical~~ Medical, Reel 4.0.2, Allen Special)

He wants Rankin not access be held to the "Allegation" and that they not be made part of the Commission's official records.
