Mr. Hoover called and advised that since receipt of this cablegram from the Ambassador in Mexico City he is very much concerned. He suggested that we should send an Agent immediately to Mexico to explore or to prove this situation completely. He instructed that arrangements be made to get an Agent to Mexico as quickly as possible and an Agent who has some background knowledge of the case and internal security and can speak Spanish.

Mr. Hoover was informed we would immediately get on this, find an Agent who can meet these requirements and get him en route as quickly as possible.
