Admiral George G. Burkley, JFK's White House Physician

Use "Breach of Trust" for background and other useful information on Admiral Burkley. Especially his death certificate of JFK. Where he places JFK's back wound.

Use Google (or some other search engine) for Admiral George G. Burkley. Under Google one of the cites provides Burkley's oral history that he provided the Kennedy Library. Worth looking out for color material but don't expect any earth-shaking revelations. Interview with a McHugh.

A copy of Henry Hurt's "Reasonable Doubt: An Investigation into the Assassination of John F. Kennedy. (A copy in the Weisberg archive on 4th floor of Library). See especially his phone interviews with Burkley.

Note: Burkley was never called as a Commission witness.

Note: Do a search in a News Paper. I would suggest the New York Times by first checking the Times' Index for 1963/1964 to see what reference, if any, about Burkley's promotion by Pres. Lyndon Johnson. Index should be available on first floor of Library.

Check the course Manual for a copy of the Kennedy death certificate. May give a clue why Burkley was never called as a witness.
