ON THE QUESTION OF WHY LEE OSWALD FELT THAT HE COULD NOT GET HIS MEXICAN
VISA EXTENDED WITHOUT USING HIS REAL NAME, THE FOLLOWING MAY BE GERMANE: MEXICAN
IMMIGRA TION RECORDS CHECKED BY THE U.S. COMSULATE IN NUEVO LAREDO AND REPORTED

THAT
ENTERED MEXICO ON 26 SEPTEMBER 1963 USING THE HAME PLANEY OSWALD LEE. IT MAY BE
THAT OSWALD FEARED THAT ANY ATTEMPT TO EXTEND HIS VISA WOULD RESULT IN DISCOVERY THAT
HE WAS IN THE COUNTRY UNDER A FALSE NAME; HE MIGHT HAVE HAD TO SHOW SOME
THE NAME OF HARVEY OSWALD LEE.

THE ALLUSION TO A MAN, PRESUMABLY A CUEAN CONSULAR OFFICIAL, WHO HAD SINCE BETT REPLACED, MAY BE EXPLAINED ASK FOLLOWS:

OSWALD HAD AN ARGUMENT WITH CUEAN CONSUL AZCUE, WHO IS EUSEBIO AZCUE LOPEZ, BORN AZCUT 1912. DOUBTLESS OSWALD MEANT AZCUE WHEN HE SAID HE WAS GLAD A CERTAIN MAN HAD BEEN REPLACED, BY COINCIDENCE, AZCUE, WHO HAD BEEN IN MEXICO FOR ABOUT 18
