Reports his story to US Embassy in Managua on
11/26

- Notes Don Alvarado presents himself as "Nicaraguan
underground member" - But he is also "a regular
informant of the Sonoran Security Service. He has
been reporting to CIA ~~in Managua~~ for over a year.

> "We consider his reliability to be questionable
although he has not been wholly discredited."

> note: Agency files do not show where [he] actually
was on 9/18

Oswald using his true name -

major pt. made in his Summary of 12/10/1962

- see pt. Clearly show that Oswald was in Mexico to
get visit to Cuba and then into ~~Havana~~ Russia. According to CIA
- only CIA being up is his possible talk w/ Kostikov
- > goal in Duran's interest - It was urged by CIA
- > when did CIA try take over the direction of the
Oswald investigation - several days prior case broke
