Dear Director Kelley:

This is in further reference to my letters to you dated October 17
 and October 20, 1975, relating to the hearing to be held by this
 Subcommittee on October 28, 1975, and the general subject of FBI
 record-keeping systems.

In preparation, we request that the following be delivered to
 the Subcommittee office by Friday, October 24, of this week:

- 1) A copy of the report submitted by the FBI to the Department of Justice on the investigation conducted by the FBI into the destruction of the so-called Oswald threat letter. This is the report referred to in the testimony presented by FBI Deputy Associate Director James Adams before the House Judiciary subcommittee on October 21, 1975.
- 2) A copy of the letter to the FBI from the Department of Justice in which the Department advises that it declines to prosecute on the basis of the investigation conducted by the FBI into the destruction of the Oswald letter.
- 3) Copies of the memoranda, records or other writings concerning disciplinary action taken against each person who was disciplined as a result of conduct in the investigation of Lee Harvey Oswald, prior to and subsequent to the death of President Kennedy, and of the assassination itself.
